

PUBLIC NOTICE: The Honey Brook Collaborative Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Plan And Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) for the East and West Branches of the Brandywine Creek and their unnamed tributaries, the Christiana River Basin, and Pequea Creek/Chesapeake Bay Watershed is available for public review at Honey Brook Borough Hall located at 71 Pequea Avenue, Honey Brook PA 19344 during regular offices hours held on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8:00am to 1:00pm. This plan is a joint effort between Honey Brook Township and Honey Brook Borough. Written comments from the public will be accepted at the Borough Hall from August 1 through August 31, 2017. Verbal and written comments will also be accepted during the regularly scheduled Honey Brook Borough Council meeting to be held on August 7, 2017 at 7:00 pm at Borough Hall. The PRP / TMDL Plan describes the existing loading of pollutants discharged from the Honey Brook Township and Honey Brook Borough MS4 to the East and West Branches of the Brandywine and their unnamed tributaries, the Christiana River Basin and Pequea Creek/Chesapeake Bay Watershed (Honey Brook Township only) and presents a plan to reduce these pollutants, which is a requirement of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permitting process.
